INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

- Must possess a current State of Ohio OPOTA Peace Officer Certificate and be either a full-time police officer in any jurisdiction in the State of Ohio with 1 year experience, or be an active member of the Shelby Police Department Auxiliary with 1 year experience.
- Each candidate must presently be, or at the time of his/her hire at their current department of employment, between the age of eighteen and thirty-one.
- If considered for hire the candidate must:
 1. Pass a medical examination
 2. Pass a physical abilities test
 3. Pass a drug test
 4. Pass a background check
 5. Pass a psychological evaluation
- Must possess a valid State of Ohio driver's license
- Must possess a high school diploma or GED
