

Mission Statement

This Specialized Docket Program is to slow and reduce recidivism by offering participants intervention and treatment. Being able to assist them in taking responsibility in an accountability-based and community supported program. Allowing participants to be accountable for their actions and lifestyle choices, participants will be able to see the community and Court support and encouragement to modify their current lifestyles. In which we will then enhance community safety and at the same time reduce the costs of the criminal justice services.

Incentives: (some examples)

- Encouragement and Praise
- Reducing supervision
- Expanding privileges
- Gift of inspirational items
- Gift cards
- Reducing Jail days
- Graduating successfully

Sanctions: (some examples)

- Warning from the Judge
- Demotion to earlier phase
- Increase drug tests/Court appearances
- Denying expanded privileges
- Increasing supervision
- Requiring Community service
- Jail time imposed/Probation Violation
- Termination from the Program

Treatment Court was developed to help out those that are addicted to drugs and/or alcohol within our Community. This is a voluntary program for those that are struggling with addiction and opt to get the support from the Court and Treatment Team involved. Treatment Court can hold up to twenty-five participants that are willing to change their lives for the better.
