



Level One Certification in Food Protection Training Registration

All food operations, including license risk level 1, 2, 3, and 4, are required to have at least one person-in-charge per shift certified in Level One Food Protection. Some operations that opened prior to March 1, 2010 are not required, but encouraged, to have one person in charge per shift certified in Level One Food Protection. All food operations must have a person in charge able to demonstrate knowledge of safe food handling and sanitation in order to prevent foodborne illnesses. All entry level food workers would benefit from this training.

The Shelby City Health Department is offering a 2.5 hour Level One Certification in Food Protection course for \$10 per person. This course will cover Food source, personal hygiene and handwashing, cross contamination, cleaning/sanitizing of equipment and utensils, and proper cooking, cooling, and holding of food. This course is approved by the Ohio Department of Health and is valid state-wide.
