

PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR
RESCINDING EMERGENCY DECLARATION

On March 19, 2020 I set forth a Proclamation of Emergency Declaration establishing orders designed to limit the spread of the COVID-19 Virus in the City of Shelby.

In light of the dramatic decline in COVID-19 case counts in our City and the ongoing vaccination efforts in our Community, I am hereby terminating the aforementioned Declaration of Emergency and all orders and the modifications of the orders contained therein.

Our Shelby City Health Department will stay in close contact with the Ohio Department of Health. We will also continue to publish and follow the guidance set forth by the Ohio Department of Health. In the coming weeks and months, we will be monitoring the public health of our citizens.


Citizens are urged to be diligent about maintaining healthy best practices, such as: the wearing of facial coverings in appropriate situations, social distancing, and thorough hand washing.
