

#### ORDINANCE NO. 22 - 2021 (Sponsors- Councilmembers Gates & Martin)

### AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.: 8-2021 (ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2021, the Council of the City of Shelby passed its Annual Appropriations Ordinance as required by the Ohio Revised Code §5705.38; and

WHEREAS, on April 19, 2021, the Council of the City of Shelby passed RESOLUTION NO. 17-2021 affirming funds received from the American Rescue Plan Act may be expended to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of the "American Rescue Plan Act," (ARPA) and any applicable regulations; and

WHEREAS, monies received from the American Rescue Plan Act have been received and deposited into a fund entitled "Local Fiscal Recovery Fund"; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to create line items within the 2021 budget and to fund said line items with ARPA monies; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Shelby that these additional appropriations be made effective so as to fund ARPA expenditures and/or projects and to balance the books for the calendar year 2021.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHELBY, OHIO, A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) MAJORITY ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1: The Ordinance No.: 8-2021 (Annual Appropriations) is hereby amended as follows:

ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PARCELS OF LAND KNOWN AS THE SHULER/MOORE ANNEXATION IN JACKSON TOWNSHIP, RICHLAND COUNTY, TO THE CITY OF SHELBY.

WHEREAS, a petition for annexation of certain territory in Jackson Township, Richland County, Ohio, was duly filed by a group of property owners who designated as their agent Andrew J. Medwid, with the Richland County Commissioners on June 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Richland County, Ohio, certified the transcript of the proceedings in connection with the annexation of the territory with the map and petition required in connection therewith to the Finance Director as Clerk of Council of the City of Shelby, the date of receipt being July 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, sixty (60) days from the date of said filing with the Finance Director as Clerk of Council have now passed in accordance with the provisions of Ohio Revised Code 709.04; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Shelby that the parcels of land known as the Shuler/Moore Annexation in Jackson Township, Richland County, Ohio, be annexed into the City of Shelby.

Section 1: That the proposed annexation as applied for in the petition of a group of property owners who designated as their agent Andrew J. Medwid, which was filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Richland County, Ohio, and which prayed for annexation to the City of Shelby, and which was approved for annexation by the Board of County Commissioners of Richland County, Ohio, on July 1, 2021, be and the same is hereby accepted.
