POSITION SUMMARY Under immediate supervision, is responsible for performing any and all tasks in connection with the Water Treatment Plant, for performing water quality tests, and doing general maintenance at the Water Plant. Shall acquire the skills and knowledge to be promoted to the position of Operator within one year of holding the Operator, Trainee position. Performs other related tasks as required. Regular and predictable attendance.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE POSITION

30% - Through training, understands the necessary knowledge, licenses and certifications to operate the water plant. Learns how to perform water quality tests for Chlorine, Hardness, Alkalinity, PH, Turbidity and Fluoride to be lab certified by the Ohio EPA.

30% - Through training, understands the necessary knowledge on how to make adjustments to the raw water flow, plant production and chemicals to ensure proper treatment of the water. Learns how to troubleshoot and perform maintenance on the equipment associated with the water plant.

20% - Through training, understands the necessary knowledge on the treatment, equipment, and chemicals used at the reservoirs. Training will also consist of preparing the operational reports necessary for the water plant.

20% - Performs general maintenance of the water plant and grounds including; mowing, trimming, painting, raking, sweeping, and any general maintenance deemed necessary by the Superintendent or the Chief Operator.

<u>NON-ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE POSITION</u> This job description in no manner states or implies that these are only duties and responsibilities to be performed by this position. Percentage of duties and responsibilities can change by availability of work. Other duties may be assigned.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES This job has no supervisory responsibility.

Must possess an operational laboratory certificate from the Ohio EPA within one year of hire. Retention of such license and certificates are a condition of continued employment.

High School diploma or G.E.D. is required.
