FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC

The City of Shelby, Ohio is seeking lateral transfer candidates for a full time Firefighter/Paramedic position. At the time of application, candidates must have a minimum of one year as a Firefighter Level II/ Paramedic and be certified and in good standing as a Level II Firefighter and preferred Paramedic with the State of Ohio. Candidates with Firefighter Level II combined with EMT B or EMT I may also be considered for a lateral transfer. Candidates must have a satisfactory record of employment with another jurisdiction as a Firefighter/Paramedic. Each candidate must presently be, or at the time of his/her hire at their current department of employment, between the age of eighteen and forty-one. This employment must be as a full-time employee. If considered for hire, the candidate must pass a medical examination, physical abilities test, drug testing, background check and psychological examination. The base salary range is \$56,856 to \$66,337. Additional wage opportunities include: holiday pay, certification pay, longevity pay, uniform allowance and overtime opportunities. The City of Shelby also offers excellent fringe benefits. Entry rate is based on years of experience, skills, knowledge and abilities. Candidates must complete and submit an application packet at Shelby City Hall, 43 West Main Street Shelby, Ohio 44875. Application paperwork may be downloaded from this web site and turned into City Hall. Applications will be kept for one year and will be considered as openings are available.
