### ORDINANCE NO. <u>35</u>-2025 (Sponsor: Councilmember McLaughlin)

VACATING A PORTION OF AN ALLEY RUNNING PARALLEL BETWEEN WEST TUCKER AVENUE AND EARL AVENUE WITHIN THE CITY OF SHELBY, RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of October 2025, the Council of the City of Shelby adopted Resolution No. 31-2025 declaring its intent to vacate a portion of an alley running parallel between West Tucker Avenue and Earl Avenue; and

WHEREAS, notice of adoption of the above resolution has been given to the owners of property abutting said roadways effected by said resolution, notifying said property owners of the time and place at which objections could be presented to the Board of Revision of Assessments (pursuant to Section 105 of the Charter of the City of Shelby); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Revision of Assessments met on December 8, 2025 and voted to approve and recommend the vacation of a portion of an alley running parallel between West Tucker Avenue and Earl Avenue; said hearing and procedure being in accordance with the provisions of Section 105 of the Charter of the City of Shelby, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause for vacating said roadway hereinafter described and that said vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest and public welfare.

### NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHELBY, OHIO, A MAJORITY ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1: That a portion of an alley running parallel between West Tucker Avenue and Earl Avenue as set forth in the plat and legal description as prepared by Hanning Surveying, LLC-Matt Hanning, Registered Surveyor on August 14, 2025 is hereby vacated.

Section 2: That in accordance with Section 105 of the Charter of the City of Shelby, Ohio, the City shall retain any and all easements necessary for the maintenance of utilities currently located within said roadway.

Section 3: That all meetings and hearings concerning the adoption of this Ordinance have been in compliance with Codified Ordinance 220.01, Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22, and the Charter of the City of Shelby, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 1: That the Mayor as Director of Public Service shall be and is hereby authorized to enter into Contract Change Order with Kokosing Construction Company, Inc. for the total amount of Six Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Seven and 18/100 Dollars (\$6,137.18) as an increase.

Section 2: That all meetings and hearings concerning the adoption of this Resolution have been in compliance with Codified Ordinance 220.01, Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22, and the Charter of the City of Shelby, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution is hereby deemed to be an emergency and therefore, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and the earliest period allowed by law.
