RESOLUTION NO. 6-2026

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AS DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT AMENDMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) RELATING TO A LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCY (LPA) FEDERAL LOCAL-LET PROGRAM FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND, DOLLARS (\$772,000.00) FOR COSTS RELATING TO THE MICKEY ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT (RIC-PID 121396).

WHEREAS, on December 2, 2024, Shelby City Council passed Resolution 56-2024 authorizing the Mayor as Director of Public Service to sign a project agreement with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation for the Mickey Road Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shelby has been awarded a Safety Grant for the installation of sidewalks on Mickey Road which requires an amendment to the original agreement to add the sidewalks to the project; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Shelby that the Mayor as Director of Public Service be authorized to enter into an amendment to the original agreement for said funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHELBY, OHIO, A MAJORITY ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1: That the Mayor as Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement amendment with the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation (ODOT) relating to LPA Federal Local-Let Project program funding in an amount not to exceed, Seven Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Dollars (\$772,000.00) or 90% of the eligible project costs for the installation of the sidewalks (PID 121396) which amendment shall be substantially in the form of Exhibit "1" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2: That all meetings and hearings concerning the adoption of this Resolution have been in compliance with Codified Ordinance 220.01, Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 and the Charter of the City of Shelby, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and the earliest period allowed by law.

RESOLUTION NO. 7-2026

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AS DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS LOCAL 18S UNIT A FOR A ONE PERCENT (1%) INCREASE TO THE EMPLOYEES' WAGES FOR THE 2026 CALENDAR YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Administration desires to implement a one percent (1%) cost of living wage adjustment to the International Union of Operating Engineers (IUOE), Local 18S Unit A contractual wage structure for the calendar year 2026; and

WHEREAS, the one percent (1%) wage adjustment would amend the wages in the current Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Shelby and the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 18S Unit A, Article 41 (Wages), Section 41.01 and the wage grades in Appendix A Wages from a three percent (3%) wage increase to a four percent (4%) wage increase; and

WHEREAS, the members of the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 18S Unit A ratified by vote on January 27, 2026 to approve the one percent (1%) wage increase to the collective bargaining agreement for the year 2026; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Shelby that the Mayor as Director of Public Service be authorized to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding as shown in Exhibit A with the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 18S Unit A to establish an additional one percent (1%) wage increase adjustment to the collective bargaining agreement for the 2026 calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHELBY, OHIO, A MAJORITY ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1: That the Mayor as Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 18S Unit A to establish an additional one percent (1%) wage adjustment to the collective bargaining agreement as stated in Article 41 (Wages), Section 41.01 and as shown in Appendix A Wages for the 2026 calendar year.

Section 2: That all meetings and hearings concerning the adoption of this Resolution have been in compliance with Codified Ordinance 220.01, Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22, and the Charter of the City of Shelby, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and the earliest period allowed by law.
