ORDINANCE NO. 7 - 2026
(Sponsors: Councilmembers McLaughlin & Martin)

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.: 2-2026 (ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2026, the Council of the City of Shelby passed its Annual Appropriations Ordinance as required by the Ohio Revised Code §5705.38; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase line items within the 2026 appropriations and to fund said line item with previously unappropriated monies; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the public health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Shelby that these additional appropriations be made effective so as to balance the books for the calendar year 2025 and so as to fund necessary expenditure and/or projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHELBY, OHIO, A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) MAJORITY ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1: The Ordinance No.: 2-2026 (Annual Appropriations) is hereby amended as follows:

THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE IS TO INCREASE EXPENDITURES

232-CBG-536	CONSTRUCTION	\$	20,000.00
353-PCC-515	EQUIPMENT	\$	15,000.00

Section 2: That all other portions of Ordinance No.: 2-2026, not modified expressly herein, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: That all meetings and hearings concerning the adoption of this Ordinance have been in compliance with Codified Ordinance 220.01, Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22, and the Charter of the City of Shelby, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby deemed to be an emergency so as to meet the ongoing contractual and/or monetary obligations of the City of Shelby Ohio and, therefore, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and the earliest period allowed by law.
